TACO TWISTS

1 lb Grnd Beef
1 Lg Onion
2 C. Shredded Cheddar Cheese
1 Jar 8 oz Salsa
1 Can Chopped Chilies 4 oz
1 Tsp garlic powder
½ tsp hot pepper sauce
¼ tsp grnd cumin
3 Tubes 8 oz ea refrigerated crescent rolls
In a skillet, cook beef and onion; drain.
Add cheese, salsa, chilies, garlic powder, hot sauce, salt and cumin; mix well.
Unroll crescent dough and separate into 12 rectangles. Place on ungreased baking sheet Place ½ C mixture on each rectangle. Bring four corners up and pinch together. Bake at 350 for 25-30 or until golden brown.

NEW JESTER BEAD CALCULATION

THROW BEADS – All beads are the responsibility of the individual member. Expect to throw at least 1 case per parade, often 2 cases are required. The cardinal sin is to run out of beads, so it is better to have too many than not enough. For the Mardi Gras parades look for 33" x 7mm or 7.5mm purple, green & gold beads for your primary throws. Other parades may have different requirements as far as color but cost is about the same. Expect to pay \$25 - \$30 per case depending on where you purchase your throws. Specialty beads and larger beads are up to the individual and cost more. It has been a tradition of the Navarre Krewe of Jesters since our inception that we have at least a few members handing out "Kissing Flowers". These are small cloth or paper flowers in Mardi Gras colors handed to spectators in return for a kiss, usually a quick peck on the cheek but maybe you know the person :O) These flowers are available from various sources and will run less than \$3 per dozen. Stick them on a Styrofoam core and mount it on a bamboo cane (like Charlie Chaplin's).

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

BEADS & BAUBLES – The Beads & Baubles Committee is the go to place for all your Krewe t-shirts and other stuff.

Community Service – The Krewe is involved in helping the community by actively participating in the following events:

3. Making strides against Breast Cancer

Entertainment Committee organizes the Party events for the Krewe, i.e. 12th Night Party, Bloody Mary Party, etc

Float Committee designs and builds the floats.

FLOAT PROTOCOL – The Float Committee Chairperson will designate a method prior to each parade for assignment of beads poles. Usually this is a sign-up sheet passed around at the meeting(s) prior to the parade and you will pick your poles on a first come, first serve basis. If having particular beads poles is important to you, it is strongly recommended that you be at the meeting to reserve your spot, otherwise you will get what is left, if any.

Fund Raising – Raise monies to support the Krewe and its many activities.

Hospitality – Organize the Royalty, i.e. King & Queen, Queen of Hearts, etc.

Ball Committee – Organize the Mardi Gras Ball.

Membership Committee – Keeps an updated list of all members and collects yearly dues.

Parade Committee – Organizes the parade from "a to z", i.e. permits, port-a-potties, etc. List of parades that the Krewe is involved in are:
