

NAVARRE KREWE OF JESTERS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

ELIGIBILITY: The Navarre Krewe of Jesters Scholarship Award is a scholarship of \$1000.00 for up to four years, to be awarded to an accredited institution of higher learning by the Navarre Krewe of Jesters in the name of and for use by a student who meets all of the following criteria each year:

1. Must be a graduating Navarre High School student graduating in the school year that the award is given and meet any SAT or ACT requirements of selected college or university.
2. Must maintain a 2.50 GPA or better for the year the student graduates. The award of this scholarship will be announced Senior Night. If the applicant's GPA falls below 2.50 prior to Senior Night, then that applicant will be deemed ineligible.
3. Must have firm plans to attend an accredited Community College, College/University or Technical School as a full time student (12 hours or more), in the year following graduation from Navarre High School.
4. Must complete a Navarre Krewe of Jesters Scholarship Application in its entirety, including essay, and submit it to the Navarre High School Guidance Center no later than February 1, 2010. **APPLICATIONS THAT ARE TURNED IN INCOMPLETE IN ANY WAY OR TURNED IN AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.**
5. Recipient of this scholarship must maintain a 2.50 GPA at their selected college/technical school each year to qualify for the scholarship for the following year and continue to meet full time student requirements.
6. Finalists will be selected from the completed applications that are turned in to the Navarre High School Guidance Center on time. Finalists will be interviewed by the Navarre Krewe of Jesters Scholarship Committee and a scholarship recipient will be selected. All decisions are final.

PRINCIPAL PURPOSE: To provide information on the Applicant's academic, extracurricular and related experience solely for the use of the Navarre Krewe of Jesters in determining scholarship award winners. Once submitted, all applications become the exclusive property of the Navarre Krewe of Jesters.

ROUTINE USE: Used only by the Navarre Krewe of Jesters to evaluate the Applicant's relative suitability for scholarship awards. With the exception of the recipient, all applications are destroyed.

DISCLOSURE: Disclosure is voluntary on the part of the Applicant; however, the Application form must be completed to satisfy the eligibility criteria.
